

FUELLING THE FUTURE – TANKS GET AN UPGRADE

Our fuel tanks have been refurbished!

We have relined the steel tanks in the lower car park with fibreglass and replaced the fuel lines that deliver fuel to the bowser. This ensures the highest quality fuel is delivered to your boat, and underscores our commitment to quality, safety and service. Permanent marina customers receive a 40c per litre discount off the bowser price.



Wild and majestic, Broughton Island is a nature and boat lover's paradise. Whether you're looking for a truly unique day trip or an overnight adventure, we're here to help.

Broughton Island is about 14km north-east of Port Stephens and is only accessible by boat. Renowned for its remote sandy beaches, volcanic peaks and stunning, wind-swept vegetation, the island is also home to an active seabird colony, the wedgetailed shearwaters.

An ever-popular destination with our guests, it's an easy daytrip from our marina with your own boat, or you are welcome to hire one of our Boab Boats. Marina guests can also join us on one of our popular SailTime Adventures.

For those seeking an even more immersive experience, the island has five campsites that can be booked through the National Parks website (details on page 5).

THE PERFECT DAY OUT

If you're keen to explore Broughton Island and some other pearls in our Pacific oyster, here is your guide to the ultimate day out.

In August this year, our guest services manager, Carmen, and skipper, David, hosted eight marina guests on board the marina's SailTime vessel, MV Independence for an epic SailTime Adventure!

UNDERWAY AT 0800

As we motored out towards the monolithic gatekeepers of Port Stephens – the dual headlands of Tomaree and Yacaaba – we were welcomed by the familiar sight of dolphins gliding alongside us and schools of baitfish leaping for their lives.

On the way, David instructed our guests on how to approach the heads and register our journey with Marine Rescue Port Stephens (02 4981 3585).

BENNETTS BEACH. Shortly after exiting the mouth of the port, we stopped for morning tea at beautiful Bennetts Beach on the northern side of Yacaaba Head. Tucked away behind the headland, Carmen served up a scrumptious spread of cheese, biscuits, dips and a cuppa.

CABBAGE TREE ISLAND. Next stop was our local colony of fur seals which are often seen sunning themselves on the rocks at the base of the island. It's not unusual to see dozens of them lounging around; however, on this occasion, only an adult and her pup were playing ball.

BROUGHTON ISLAND. We then headed for the rugged beauty of Broughton Island. Along the way, some of our guests drove under instruction from David who taught them how to handle the boat and what to do under the prevailing conditions.

The pristine waters of Broughton Island are perfect for swimming, snorkelling, scuba diving and fishing (if you plan on fishing, you must not fish in the sanctuary zones – check your maps or download the FishSmart app).

For those wanting to stretch their legs, walking tracks dot the island.

Coal Shaft Bay. We popped in for a look at this gorgeous bay on the south side of the island. Beware of the rocky outcrops and reef – always consult your maps. Great for anchoring but no public moorings available here, and you can go ashore for a picnic or a walk; however, the cliff is steep so be prepared for a hike!



It was one of the best days on the water I've had in years!

Providence Beach and Bay. Located on the north side of the island is the picturesque Providence Beach and its neighbouring bay. A public mooring is available at the beach. The water was incredibly clear – we saw turtles swimming past!

Esmeralda Cove. On the south-eastern side of the island, at the end of a narrow inlet, sit the twin, white-sand beaches of Esmeralda Cove. This gorgeous piece of paradise was the perfect place to stop for lunch, and Carmen treated us to a delicious selection of sandwiches, salads and meats.

The moorings in the cove are all privately owned and cannot be used by the general public. Beware of the bommie/reef in the middle of the entrance to the cove. There are five basic but beautiful campsites located here (you will need your own water). Bookings can be made via the National Parks website: https://www.nationalparks.nsw.gov.au/camping-and-accommodation/campgrounds/broughton-island-campground

BOONDELBAH ISLAND. Heading home, we cruised past the Fairy penguin colony on Boondelbah Island, the most northerly breeding site of the species. Only two kilometres from the entrance to Port Stephens, this island is also an important habitat for Gould's Petrels.

A WHALE OF A TIME! As we approached the headlands, we were wowed by several mighty whales! Between May and November, thousands of humpback and southern right whales cruise up and down our coast to feed and give birth in the warmer waters. Watching these mammoth, graceful creatures breach and blow is an unforgettable experience!

JOIN US! As a guest of Soldiers Point Marina, you too can be a part of our SailTime Adventure trips. These social outings are arranged throughout the year, and as well as daytrips to Broughton Island, we also head up to the Myall Lakes and sometimes have overnight stops in Bulahdelah.





A SOLDIER'S SPIRIT ON THE OPEN SEAS

Kevin Le Poidevin, retired RAAF officer and seasoned sailor, isn't your average retiree. He's a local hero with a global mission: raising awareness and funds for charities close to his heart. Soldiers Point Marina is proud to support Kev by offering him a free berth as he prepares for his next challenge.

Kev's passion for sailing is matched only by his unwavering determination to support Brain Tumour Alliance Australia (BTAA) and Soldier On. Kev has supported Soldier On since 2012 when it was created to help service personnel transition into civilian life, many with battle scars both physical and mental.

In 2019, however, things got even more personal when one of Kev's best Defence buddies, Nathan 'Bullet' Draper, was diagnosed with glioblastoma, a Grade 4 brain tumour. At just 46 years old with two children – one in high school, one at university – Nathan was given a prognosis of 12-16 months. Before he passed away, Kev asked Nathan what he could do to help. Nathan's response: help raise awareness and money for Brain Tumour Alliance Australia (BTAA).

BTAA is a national organisation focused on supporting brain tumour patients and their carers, and the oft-forgotten families of patients. Despite the pivotal role BTAA plays in the lives of those affected by brain cancer, they do not receive any government funding.

In Kev's eyes, BTAA is the unsung hero, and this has driven him to harness his sailing skills for an extremely worthy cause.

In 2023, Kev set his sights on the 2023 Global Solo Challenge, a gruelling solo circumnavigation race in which he was Australia's only entrant. This wasn't just a test of sailing skills;



it was a platform to raise funding and awareness for BTAA. Unfortunately, the challenge had to be cut short, but Kev's spirit remained unbroken.

Back on dry land in Port Stephens, Kev isn't one to rest. Soldiers Point Marina, recognising his dedication, stepped in to offer him a berth until Christmas. This act of support allows Kev to focus on his next challenge: the 2024 Sydney Hobart Yacht Race.

But Kev's journey isn't limited to Australia. He's gearing up for the Melbourne Osaka Cup, a prestigious double-handed event held every four years. With each race, he proudly displays the logos of BTAA and Soldier On on his boat, the Roaring Forty, carrying their messages across the vast expanse of the ocean.

As one of Kev's biggest supporters, the Roaring Forty now also proudly displays the Soldiers Point Marina's logo on its hull.

Kev invites anyone to visit him at his boat here at the marina, not just to have a look at his vessel and to hear about his adventures, but to learn about the causes he champions.
